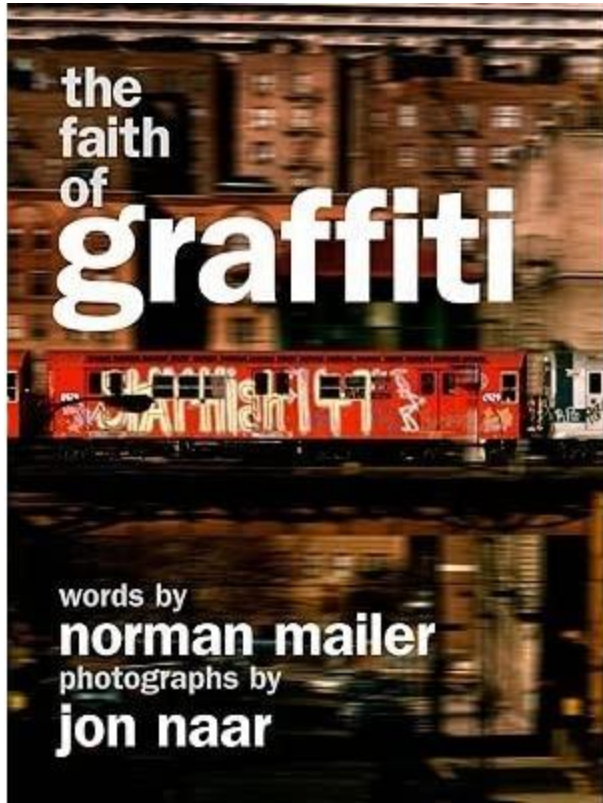

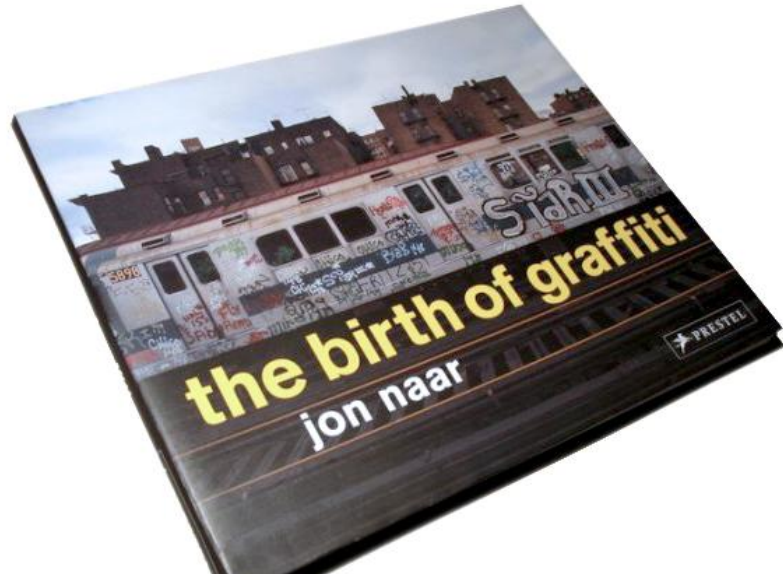
Sujan Sarker, a primary school teacher in India's West Bengal, was on his way to class when he captured this award winning photo.

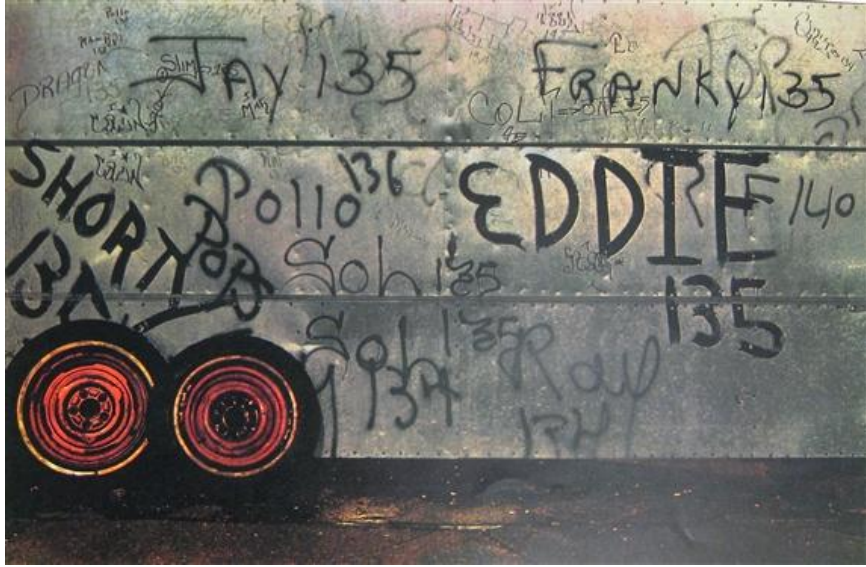
